- Resolution 8 on Collection and Dissemination of Information and Statistics, calls on ITU to “provide technical assistance to the relevant national authorities for the collection and dissemination of ICT statistics...”
- ITU is the official source for global ICT statistics. It relies primarily on information provided by Member States, and had the mandate to strengthen the capacity of member administrations.
