STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDRES FOR INTERNATIONAL VSAT CONNECTIVITY AND IT ENABLING SERVICES UNDER LDI FRANCHISE

Pakistan Telecommunication Authority has exclusive power under the Pakistan Telecommunication (Re-organization) Act 1996, to issue licenses to establish, maintain or operate any telecommunication system or provide any telecommunication service in Pakistan. Pakistan Telecommunication Authority is pleased to issue the following Standard Operating Procedure SOP for establishment of international VAST connectivity and IT enabling services under LDI franchise:

- 1. The LDI franchisee shall be allowed for international VAST connectivity from the Registered Satellite Service Provides in Pakistan.
- 2. The applicant should submit complete proposal to Authority through LDI before establishment of VAST link along with following requirements:
 - a. Application form shall be filled in for each link site by the applicant and shall be submitted to the Authority (10 Copies).
 - b. Technical specification of the VAST link including schematic diagram, detail of allied equipment to be installed at the proposed sites (10 Copies).
 - c. Site co-ordinates of the location duly verified by the Survey of Pakistan or from commercially available GPS operator (10 Copies).
 - d. Technical details and name of satellite, which will be used for VAST link.
 - e. Name/designation of responsible contact person from LDI and franchise company along with attested copies of NIC (10 Copies).
 - f. Area Map for the site in Pakistan on A4 size paper (10 Copies).
 - g. Application processing fee Rs. 1000/- for each link in the form of Demand Draft payable to Authority.
- 3. The Authority will issue the permission to establish and maintain International VAST link under LDI Franchise after evaluating the proposal within seven (7) days, after final permission and clearance from concerned agencies.
- 4. The Authority shall send each case to Security Agencies for security clearance, and PTA will also be responsible to get security clearance from concerned agencies.
- 5. The LDI franchisee shall not be allowed to shift its VAST link without prior approval of the Authority.
- 6. The LDI franchisee shall make necessary arrangement for inspection of its international VAST connectivity as and when required by the Authority.
